Cleaning

All chrome surfaces should be cleaned using a clean damp cloth.

No abrasive cleaning agents or materials should be used.

General glass cleaner can be used for the screen, but ensure that this will not damage the chrome, check the cleaning information on the product before use.







- *** The unit can only be installed by fully qualified electrician.
- 1. Position the mirror in a suitable location,make sure the domestic electrical mains supply is within reach of the electrical entry point of the product.
- Carefully mark the position of the mirror using a soft pencil ensuring it is level.
 Remove the mirror and mark the mounting points. Please ensure that all marked mounting points accurately match up with the fixing points on the mirror.
- 3. Using a suitable drill bit, drill holes in the marked positions to a suitable depth.

- 4. Insert wall plugs level with the surface of the wall. If fitting to a tiled surface, wall plugs should be inserted below the tile surface to avoid cracking.
- 5. Screw supplied fixings into wall plugs on position A.
- 6. Ensure the domestic electrical mains supply to which the mirror is being connected is turned off. Connect the domestic mains supply to the wires on top of the mirror cabinet --- the live wire in brown and neutral wire in blue.
- 7. Hang the cabinet onto the screws (Position A). Then open the cabinet door panel, thread in the screws on position B to secure the cabinet, put screw covers onto screws.
