DESCRIPTION:

Polymer modified flexible grout suitable for joints between tiles up to 20mm.

When cured it is water resistant and suitable for internal and external use.

Ensure tiles are firmly fixed before grouting. Joints must be clean

UNDERFLOOR HEATING:

Suitable for under floor heating. Allow 48 hours for the grout to set before introducing heat gradually.

TILE GROUTING:

Add grout powder to clean cold tap water in a clean container and mix to a smooth slightly stiff consistency either by hand or using a mechanical mixing paddle.

Addition rate 4 parts by weight of powder to 1 part water. Do not use excess water during mixing or washing down as this can lead to staining or efflorescence on the surface of the grout. Mix only sufficient that can be used within 30 minutes. Product that has started to set must be discarded. Work the grout into the joints to ensure they are completely filled. Clean surplus grout from the tiles and joints as soon as possible as set grout will be difficult to remove later. Polish the surface with a soft dry cloth.

The tiles should be maintained with Granfix EasiCare products.
