


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Create the recess in the wall to accommodate the mixer being installed. Mark the installation holes through the lugs in the mixer body. Drill the holes.

Drill the holes. Insert the wall plugs. Secure the mixer into position using the screws provided Connect the inlet and outlet pipe work to the mixer using an adequate sealing method. Turn on the water supply and check for leaks before fitting the cover plate.





Maintenance

After a period of use, debris or limescale can build up around the filters of the thermostat or the non-return valve, which will affect the performance of the product.

To resolve this, remove the thermostat or non-return valve from the mixer and clean.


Turn off the water supply and turn on the mixer, to drain any water inside

Maintenance (Filter)



1) Remove the check valve clamp cap. 2) Use pilers to remove the check valve and filter. 3) Wash the filter with clean running water, dry and lightly grease the seals. (only use silicone grease). 4) Put back the filter and check valve, then tighten the clamp cap.

Maintenance (Thermostatic Cartridge)



The concealed thermostatic cartridges should give trouble free service, but in the event of failure, servicing is straight forward. 1) Remove the cartridge clamp cap .


2) Pull out the thermostatic cartridge.
3) Wash the thermostatic cartridge with clean running water, dry and lightly grease the seals (only use silicone grease). 4) Put back the thermostatic cartridge, then tighten the clamp cap.

CLEANING

To maintain the surface of your product, wipe with a clean damp cloth and wipe dry. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials which can strip and scratch the surface; the use of these agents or materials can invalidate your guarantee. It is recommended to wipe and dry on a regular basis.




TRIPLE VALVE:




2.Once checked, install the cover plate, silicone should be applied between the plate and the wall, push this onto the mixer, ensuring correct orientation, so that the markings match the control on the mixer


Finally install the handle assembly, by fitting the handle to the valve, then tighten the retaining screw, followed by the peg or cover cap



3.To ensure correct temperature setting, Face A on the stop ring should be aligned with the mark on the thermostatic cartridge, if it is not, align these by turning the spindle before fitting the handle



4.Once the marks are aligned place the handle onto the thermostat so that lug B on the inside of the handle sits against Face A on the stop ring, once the handle is fitted onto the thermostat, turn the handle towards cold, then back to the 38c position, if the correct alignment has been achieved you will need to press the button and continue turning to go beyond the 38c stop position.



OPERATION

To open the mixer, turn on/off handle anti-clockwise. To close the mixer, turn on/off handle clockwise

To decrease temperature, turn the temperature control handle clockwise. To increase temperature turn the temperature control handle anti-clockwise RECALIBRATE

The temperature control handles on this product are factory set and should require no adjustment.

However, if for any reason the handles and/or the cartridge is removed, it is important the following procedures are followed.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

1. Output water temperature does not correspond with temperature set Cause: Thermostat has not been adjusted base on the existing home water system Remedy: Adjust the thermostat , refer to "Temperature Setting" procedure.

Cause: Hot Water temperature too low.

Remedy: Adjust the water heater , increase hot water temperature to 65 °C. 2. Crossflow, cold water being forced into hot water pipe, or vice versa, when valve is closed

Cause: Non-return valves dirty or leaking

Remedy: Clean the non-return valves or exchange if necessary 3. Very low flow or no flow

Cause: Supply pressure inadequate

Remedy: Check hot and cold feeds . If a pump has been installed, please check to see if the pump is working (the valve will shut down if either the cold or hot water supply fails)

4. Water will not run hot enough when first installed

Cause: Wrong maximum temperature setting Remedy: Adjust the maximum temperature , refer to "Temperature Setting" procedure.





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

Installation

Please note: No tools are required

- 1. Place the washer into swivel joint of the shower head (please refer to parts diagram for location).
- 2. Connect the swivel joint to the shower arm (not supplied) and tighten using a spanner, taking care not to damage the nut.

Troubleshooting

Poor flow from shower head

- 1. This can be caused by poor water flow to the shower head, check the flow to the shower head.
- 2. There may be a blockage in the shower head, clean the shower head.

Maintenance

- Remove the shower head and turn on the mixer. Check the flow of water, and if this is poor, it is not an issue with the shower head, and further investigation is required. Example: insufficient pressure in the system or blockage in the mixer or pipework.
- If your shower head has rubber nozzles, rub these with your finger to remove any blockage then turn on the shower, but do not shower immediately, allow the hand shower to flush through for 10 seconds.
- If the shower head does not have rubber nozzles and only has holes, brush the holes with a soft brush under warm running water to remove any blockage.
- Replace the shower head if the issue is not a pressure issue, blockage in the mixer and the shower head has been cleaned.

Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean after every use, using a clean damp cloth, a mild detergent mixture can be used. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface.

If any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.



Installation


Please note: The pipework and connection method should be prepared within the wall

Recommended method is to secure the arm to a wall elbow which has been fixed rigidly within the wall.

1. Fit the wall trim plate onto the arm then apply sufficient PTFE tape to the thread of the shower arm which will go into the wall, so that when aligned, the arm will be sealed within the wall elbow.



2. Once PTFE has been applied push the shower arm into the hole in the wall and connect it to the elbow then turn the shower arm into the elbow until a seal is created.



3. Once fitted and checks have been carried out for leaks, push the wall trim plate back to the finished wall. Silicone can be applied behind to prevent moisture passing behind the wall trim plate.

Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean after every use, using a clean damp cloth, a mild detergent mixture can be used. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface.

If any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.

Installation



1.Locate the rail on the wall ensuring that when the hand shower is at its highest point the hose is not under tension, also ensuring the rail is vertical using a sprit level. 2.Once this is done, place the wall brackets on each of the rail and mark the position of the fixing holes. 3.Drill the wall 8mm dia and to 45mm depth and insert the wall plugs

4.Fit the slider bracket/hand shower holder to the rail ensuring the hand shower holder on the rail has the wider opening facing upwards.
5.The hand shower should be connected to the cone end of the hose, ensuring to fit

the seals and the nut end to the mixer, then tighten.

CLEANING

To maintain the surface of your product, wipe with a clean damp cloth and wipe dry. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials which can strip and scratch the surface; the use of these agents or materials can invalidate your guarantee. It is recommended to wipe and dry on a regular basis.






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Square and Round Wall Elbow BeBa_26371 & BeBa_26372



Installation


Please note: The pipework and connection method should be prepared within the wall

Recommended method is to secure the arm to a wall elbow which has been fixed rigidly within the wall.


1. Apply sufficient PTFE tape to the short end of the threaded bar and screw this into the rear of the wall elbow until a seal is created.



2. Apply sufficient PTFE to the thread of the long thread of the wall elbow which will go into the wall. Place the thread through the hole in the wall and screw this into the fitting within the wall.



3. Continue screwing the thread into the fitting until a seal is created and the outlet for the hose is pointing downwards and, the wall elbow is flush with the finished wall. Silicone can be applied if necessary.



Please note: Once installation is completed, turn on the water supply and check for any leaks

Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean after every use, using a clean damp cloth, a mild detergent mixture can be used. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface.

If any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.
