

Warning: Please use a soft cloth to protect the tool or cover the surface to prevent any scratches.

Installation Steps

Step 1

Lay the bath on a soft place to protect it from scratches, and screw off the six adjustable legs (You may keep these feet for future use). See Figure 1, and 2





Step 2





Figure 3 Figure 4

As shown in the figure 3&4, place and install Feet-A and Feet-B around the bottom of the bath, but do not tighten the nuts at this stage. Note that Feet-A(with long bracket) need to be installed on the side close to the overflow. The two middle feet can be directly installed with adjusting feet (Parts C).

Step 3

Adjust the legs Part C, so that feet A and B are 1-2mm above floor level, as the feet A and B do not take the bath load, these are purely visual. Check the adjustable legs (Parts C) by using a level and tighten the nuts connecting the legs and the bath. See Figure 5

Step 4

Adjust the metal brackets to a proper angle to make sure they fit well on the bath and then fasten the nuts. Double check to make sure the adjustable legs are sitting flat, when you place the bath in the desired location. Adjust the legs (Parts C) if needed. See Figure 4, and 6





Maintenance & Cleaning

- 1. Gently wipe the surface with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using rough materials (e.g., scouring pads) to prevent scratching.
- 2. For stains, wipe the affected area gently with a cloth dampened in warm water, then dry thoroughly with a clean cloth.
- 3. Do not use acidic or alkaline cleaners (e.g., bleach, vinegar), as they may damage the paint coating.
- 4. After each use, promptly wipe off water stains with a clean cloth to prevent rusting.
