




Installation

Please note: Before starting the installation of a new mixer, turn off the water supply

Please note: HOT supply to the left and COLD supply to the right

- 1. Remove back nuts and washers if fitted to tap when received
- 2. Place base plates if provided, onto tap tails
- 3. Place tap tails through holes in bath/basin
- 4. From underneath the bath/basin fit washers and back nuts and tighten into position
- 5. Connect to water supply, making a watertight seal
- 6. Turn on water supply and check for leaks

Maintenance



Cleaning

To maintain the surface finish of your product, wipe clean regularly, using a clean damp cloth and dry cloth to polish. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents or materials on the product surface as you may invalidate your guarantee. Should any harsh chemicals come into contact with the surface of the product during bathroom cleaning, rinse off immediately, wipe clean and dry.
