Please Note: There are two different types of fitting bracket please check which style is on the mirror you have purchased.



1. Measure the distance between the two brackets on the back of the mirror

Mark the distance on the wall.

2. Check the marks are level and drill the holes.

3.1 If the mirror is secured by screws, insert the wall plug, thread in the screws and hang the mirror onto the screws.

3.2 If the mirror is secured by the hooks, insert the wall plugs, position the hooks and thread in the screws to fix the hooks, then hang the mirror onto the hooks.

**Please note:**

**make sure the holes on the wall and on the hooks are lined up**

c) Damage or loss resulting from electrical surges or lightning strikes or other acts which are not the fault of us or which the product is not specied to tolerate.

d) Damage or loss resulting from normal and customary wear and tear, such as gloss

reduction, scratching or fading over time due to use, cleaning practices or water or atmospheric conditions, including but not limited to, the use of bleach, alkali, acid cleaners, dry (powder) cleaners or any other abrasive cleaners or the use of metal or nylon scrubbers.

4. All surfaces should be wiped down with a clean cloth, no abrasive cleaning agents or material's can be used.
